
Pursuant to KRS 160.346, the Diagnostic Review Team has examined extensive evidence and arrived at the following recommendations:

**The principal does not have the ability to lead the intervention and should not remain as principal of Doss High School to continue the roles and responsibilities established in KRS 160.345.**





**RE: Notice of Diagnostic Review Determination for Doss High School**

Dear Leadership of Jefferson County Schools and Doss High School:

Please find enclosed the diagnostic review report and the commissioner's determination for the above referenced school. This determination is made pursuant to the requirements of KRS 160.346 and 703 KAR 5:180. KRS 160.346 (5) states as follows:

Within thirty (30) days of the commissioner's action on the audit teams' recommendations, the school council or local board of education may appeal the commissioner's action to the Kentucky Board of Education by submitting a written request, including any supporting information. The Kentucky Board of Education shall consider the audit reports, the commissioner's decision, and the request for consideration with any supporting information, and make a final determination. If the state board is not scheduled to meet within thirty (30) days following the receipt of an appeal of the commissioner's decision, the board chair shall call a special meeting for action upon the appeal.

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The receipt of the report and commissioner's determination, confirmed by the signature/date page of the report entitled "School Diagnostic Review Summary Report," is the official notification of the commissioner's action on the audit team's recommendations. As a result, the council and/or local board of education has thirty (30) days from the date of delivery of the report (date of this letter) to submit a written request for an appeal to the Kentucky Board of Education. The appeal process is not mandatory but is available if the council or local board of education so elects.
