Appendix B: Methodology and Bill Lists

A team of LWVKY researchers used the Kentucky General Assembly's online *Legislative Record* to investigate bills passed in seven regular legislative sessions: 1998, 2002, 2006, 2010, 2014, 2018, and 2022. The Legislative Record is a cumulative document compiled by the Legislative Research Commission at the end of each day in the legislative session. The Record contains a digest of all bills, resolutions, and amendments and summarizes all daily legislative action on the House and Senate floor. It can be found online at legislature.ky.gov/Legislation. 1998 was the earliest 60-day regular session available there, and 2022 the most recent.

We looked at every bill that became law in those sessions, coding each bill based on the process used to pass it (see coding guide below). One member did a first version of entering codes and notes on concerns for each step of the process. Other members checked all those codes and notes, and the team reconciled any differences. Based on that quality control step, we also made the notes clearer and more consistent.
