



The 7 Capacities of Rose in KY

In *Rose v. CBE* (1989), the Kentucky Supreme Court held that all students in the Commonwealth have a right to an adequate education.

The Court interpreted the state constitution to require the education system to be adequately funded, ensure equality, and be designed to provide every student with these 7 capacities.
