## When Drivers Have to Stop For School Buses

Understanding when a motorist is required to stop for school buses that are picking up or dropping off children can help keep students safe. Here's a breakdown of some common situations and the laws in Kentucky.

Two-lane road


When a school bus is stopped on a two-lane roadway without a median, all cars traveling in either direction must stop.

Four or more lanes without median


If the bus is on a road with four or more lanes without a median, only the cars following the bus on the same side of the road must stop.

Four or more lanes with median


If a bus is stopped on a multi-lane road with a medianwhether it's concrete, grass, or just an unpaved separationcars traveling in the opposite direction can keep moving while all cars following the bus must stop.

Four or more lanes with center turn lane


When a school bus is stopped on a road with four or more lanes and a center turn lane, only cars following the bus must stop.
